**Reservation To Address The Academic Impact Of The Pandemic (Learning Recovery)  
Required 20%**

- Proposed District Programs:
  - Class Size Reduction/Credit Recovery 70%
  - High-Quality Tutoring 12%
  - Summer Programming 9%
  - Enrichment Programs 7%
  - Extended Day Programming 2%

**Reservation To Address The Academic Impact Of The Pandemic**

- Proposed District Programs:
  - Improving indoor air quality (36%)
  - Repairing and improving school facilities to reduce risk to environmental health hazards (31%)
  - Planning for or implementing activities during closures, including providing meals to eligible students and providing technology for online learning (14%)
  - Providing mental health services and supports, including through the implementation of evidence based full-service community schools and the hiring of counselors (11%)
  - Purchasing educational technology (including hardware, software, connectivity, assistive technology, and adaptive equipment) for students that aids in regular and substantive educational interaction between students and their classroom instructors, including students from low-income families and children with disabilities (4%)
  - Developing and implementing procedures and systems to improve the preparedness and response efforts of LEAs (2%)
  - Purchasing supplies to sanitize and clean facilities (2%)
